## How to enter Theale Virtual Show Spring 2021

- **All entries are FREE!**
- Create an exhibit for the Class you choose (you can only make & enter one exhibit per Class but there are 31 Classes)
- Take one photo of each exhibit and send in your photo(s) by email to [admin@thealeflowershow.com](mailto:admin@thealeflowershow.com) together with your name. We'll confirm receipt & send you a link so you can tell us your name and contact details unless you can include these in an email.
- All entries to be submitted online to be received by 9pm on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> April. **No late entries will be accepted**
- Our Judges will consider each photograph of your exhibit in each Class and award a Voucher for First Prize in that Category. We'll contact the winners after 17 April and get their prize to them!

## Prizes for 2021

A £10 Voucher prize will be awarded for the best exhibit in each **Section** of classes, as follows:

- Children age 5 and below
- Children age 6 – 9
- Children age 10 – 13 and Young people age 14 – 18
- Handicrafts
- Flower arrangements
- Flowers/plants
- In the garden
- Photography

## Theale Show Competition Official Rules (Effective 2021)

1. All exhibits must be the work of the Exhibitor and must not have been entered in previous Theale Shows.
2. All entries to be 'virtual' in the form of one photograph. No actual objects to be submitted this year. One photograph ONLY per entry.
  - a. Only photograph the exhibit. Do not include yourself or anyone identifiable in the photo.
  - b. Your email should specify which Class you are entering.
3. Children's and Young People's exhibits must be arranged by their own hands **and must be marked to show the exhibitor's age and Class number only.**
4. Each photographed entry must be clearly marked with the Class number only for adults.
5. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class. Entries may be refused at the sole discretion of the Show Secretary.
6. The Judge's decisions are final.
7. All entries will be displayed on the website by 3pm on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> April. Winning entries will be identified with the winner's name and age if a child.
8. Theale Show reserves the right to publish in any medium it operates and at any time any submitted photo, unless the rights holder mails admin@thealflowershow.com to object.
